## By Public Transport:

From the main train station, take subway U4 or U5 directly to the Römer station. You can also take the streetcar 11 or 12 and get off at the stop Römer/ Paulskirche. If you take the S-Bahn, the closest stop is Konstablerwache.

## By Car:

Autobahn A5, exit direction city center (Stadtmitte). Following the Parking Direction System (Park-Leit-System) to the Parkhaus Dom/Römer.

## Parking:

Public parking can be found in the Braubachstraße and the Domstraße, as well as in the parking garage Römer. The entrance to the parking garage Römer is from the Domstraße.
